<u>Meeting, Date and Time</u>	A meeting of the Canning Village Commission was held on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, at 6:30 PM via Zoom.

Angela Cruickshank welcomed everyone to the meeting.	
<u>Agenda Approval</u>	<b>On Motion Bryon Crossman and Wanda Sheffield the agenda for February 8, 2022 be approved. All in favor, Motion carried.</b>
<u>Approval of Minutes</u>	<b>On Motion Wanda Sheffield and Bryon Crossman the minutes of the January 11, 2022 meeting be approved. All in Favor, Motion carried.</b>  <b>On Motion Bryon Crossman and Wanda Sheffield the minutes of the Special Meeting with the County on January 27, 2022 be approved. All in Favor, Motion carried.</b>
<u>Councillor update</u>	June sent regrets therefore nothing to report
<u>Village Financials</u>	The Commission reviewed the financials. Angela reported that the Fire Dept had purchased a new utility vehicle using the Fire Commission funds and would be also purchasing new BA's this year. They are holding off until next year for the purchase of the new engine.  Angela Cruickshank mentioned that the elliptical machine needed to be replaced as it has broken. She will do more investigation on pricing as what the Fire Dept had found was expensive. The Clerk reported that the fitness room users did use the machine often and several had said they would donate some money toward the new machine. There is also \$500 now in the budget to help with equipment replacement. The Commission agreed that we should purchase a new machine especially if we can share on the costs. An email will be sent out with the new quotes for a motion to be made.
<u>Public Works</u>	The clerk will forward the latest email from Richard Lloyd about the Main Street parking expansion. This will be further discussed in the spring.
<u>Water Utility</u>	The ICIP funding has now opened up. The clerk is waiting for updated amounts for the submission of the Chapel Road Project.
<u>Clerk's report</u>	The Commission reviewed the clerk's report.
<u>Accessibility Plans</u>	<b>On Motion Wanda Sheffield and Jenn Myers the Village of Canning approve to appoint Kirk MacLennan as the representative for the Village of Aylesford on the Joint Accessibility Advisory Committee. All in favor Motion carried.</b>  The Commission discussed the request for more funding to jointly support a full time position at the County for the Accessibility Coordinator. The Commission has agreed to the cost share for the Village's portion of \$913.50 for the 2022/23 year. The Village would like to know what services we will be getting for our share of the position. Will we be getting pinpointed information about what changes we need to address?  <b>On Motion Jenn Myers and Wanda Sheffield the Canning Village Commission agrees to cost share in the amount of \$913.50 for the 2022/23 year for the Joint Accessibility Coordinator position at the County of Kings. All in favor, Motion carried.</b>

Doctor Recruitment June and Michael met with new doctor considering the clinic. A report will come at the next meeting.

New Bldg. Development The Commission met with the County on January 27<sup>th</sup> via zoom to discuss the water utility requirements for the new development. Once we receive the info on the requirements from the Contractor the Village will respond to the County. We will also be doing more modeling of the Water Utility for future development needs.
