

Spring 2024 Clean-up in Canning

Regular Garbage Day	Spring Clean-up Week	Set out items at curbside
Friday Week 1	29th April - 3rd May*	Items must be curbside on Sunday, 28th April to guarantee collection.

***Please note that Clean-up happens on the opposite week to your regular collection. The truck will collect once during your clean-up week. No specified day or time. Collection starts at 7 am.**

Maximum of 20 items per household. An item is one single object, bag, container or securely tied bundle. Bagged items must be in **clear bags only**. Smaller items **must** be bagged!
NO recyclables, cardboard, electronics, Household Hazardous Waste or yard waste
 Remove batteries from items
NO Cooling devices such as fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers without CFC sticker.
 Items not collected are the responsibility of the resident and/or the landlord and must be removed from roadside when clean-up is finished.

Household appliances like a washer, dryer and stove. **Please note:** Any cooling devices like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers must have a CFC sticker. Limit is two appliances at one stop.

Furniture items like a sofa, mattress, shelving. Any one furniture or appliance item can weigh up to 91kg (200lb); other items must weigh no more than 34kg (75lb) each. Carpet should be rolled in 4ft lengths.

Miscellaneous items such as a water tank, boiler, empty oil storage tank (which must all be drained).

Construction Waste lumber or loose items must be bagged or tied securely in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres (4ft). Nails should be bent over or removed.

Small Auto Parts (no fuel or fluids)

RULES FOR CLEAN-UP

The truck will come by **ONCE** during your Clean-up week so **items must be out on the Sunday of your Clean-up week** so you don't miss the truck. Collection starts at 7am!

No recyclables, cardboard or yard waste are accepted for clean-up.

*Please remove batteries from items. Batteries can be brought in to the management centres or other participating locations for free.

Bagged items **must** be in clear bags. Smaller items **must** be bagged.

Maximum of 20 items will be collected at any one stop. An item means a single object, bag or container or securely tied bundle. A bundle can measure up to 4ft in length. Weight restrictions above.

Items not collected are the responsibility of the resident and must be removed from roadside when Clean-up is finished.

Cooling Devices like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers without a CFC sticker.

Electronics like televisions, computers, monitors, stereos, printers, telephones, microwaves and stereos are free to bring into the management centre or participating EPRA locations as part of the electronics program.

Automotive Tires Up to four rimless tires a day can be returned to any tire dealership, free of charge.

Large Auto Parts

Cardboard boxes can be flattened and bundled in 3ftx2ftx1ft and up to two bundles can be put out with your regular collection.
